

English Translation of Media Coverage "Puber Moina": On the initiative of three colleges of West Bengal – Bangavasi Evening College of Kolkata; Sewnarayan Rameswar Fatepuria College and Jatindra Rajendra Mahavidyalaya of Murshidabad – adequate arrangements were made to deliver relief goods to the Yaas victims in some of the islands of Sundarbans during 7th-9th June, 2021. Three joint community kitchens were temporarily set up to feed the flood-affected people living in Kumirmari and Sonargaon areas under Gosaba block of Sundarban. To this end, a stock of pulses, potatoes, onions, ginger, garlic, edible oil, cooking spices, eggs, soybeans, and so on groceries were supplied to these affected regions. By making provision of these relief items for the noble purpose of delivering food to the needy and hungry people, at least two nutritious meals a day were provided to nearly 2,000 vulnerable people in the flooded islands of the Sundarban forest.


