

Theme:

Arabic literature has a huge ancient legacy. It started its journey in pre Islamic period that is known as Al-Ayyam Al-Jahiliyya and that period ended before about 1400 years from current time.

Both prose and poetry existed in this period. Oratory was best form of prose. Besides it there was wasaya(commandments), rasayel(letters) and sajul kuhhan(cooing of priest) were prose forms.

But Arabic poetry reached its zenith. Arabic poem was known as Qasida. Qasida in this period used to follow a certain pattern. Qasida had three parts; in first part poet used to remember his former beloved and her ruined dwelling place, in second part poet would start a long journey and describe the toils of his journey, and in third part the main theme of the Qasida was hidden. Based on third part the Qasida used to be leveled as ritha(lament for dead one) or madhad(panegyric) or hija(slander) etc.Finest Qasida was the seven hanging poetry or Saba Muallagat which were hanged on the wall of ka'ba written on silk clothes in golden ink. Poets were also divided into many strata mainly three in numbers. Poets used to lead different lifes-some used to live in palace, some used to lead anti-social life. Their poetry was reflection of social-economic-political conditions of that period.



Arabic language starts its journey over 1000 years ago as a classical language which was dialect of Mecca. The language stems from the Afro-Asiatic family, it is classified as a Semitic language. The classical version of Arabic had many Sematic traits, including nonconcatenative morphology and the absence of vowels in the written scrip.

Arabic started to spread, mainly because of the nomadic tendencies of the people speaking Arabic who lived in the region. Interracial marriages between people of the Arabian Peninsula and the surrounding areas expedited the process considerably. The Arabic language spread significantly during the Islamic conquests of the 7th century C.E., entering Iberian, Chinese, and North African regions.

The early 19th century marked the starting point of Modern Standard Arabic (MSA). Contacts between Arabic-speaking nations and the Western world increased.

The dialects that emerged throughout the history of the Arabic language are still in use today. Arabic speakers communicate in several unique styles, known as "Colloquial Arabic." Today, Arabic enjoys the status of a macro language with 30 varieties, including MSA. With so many language varieties, translating English to Arabic can prove challenging.

Arabic is flourishing everyday. It's being adopted worldwide and it is also taking words from other languages like democracy, technology, electronic etc. It also has lent some words to English, such as 'algebra', 'banana', 'coffee',

'magazine', 'sugar', and more∎
