SEMINAR THEME

At first, the British East India Company set up their colony in Bengal by defeating the Nawab of Bengal in the Battle of Plassey (1757AD). Before the advent of EIC in Bengal, the indigenous education system was firmly introduced across the Bengal province and in this sector, Bengal Nawab, zaminder and other educated lover persons patronize their indigenous education system. But EIC was in different to uplift indigenous system. So, during the reign of Company rule the indigenous education system came into downtrodden position. In this regard, Company's view was different from us. They want to make a clerical class in view to use their official work. Before the advent of British in Bengal, the Muslims were the ruling elevated class with establishing a high level education system. Persian was the state language then. The economic and education system of Bengal Muslim became deteriorated day by day and they were going to submerge in the realm of darkness. Frustration and disappointment engulfed the total Muslim society. To get rid the chaotic condition, EIC first established the Calcutta Madrasa(1782) in view to educate the Muslim society. In this context, our motto and view is to sheer light on the contemporary education system of EIC and highlights the initiatives taken by Muslims of Bengal to develop their education system in British transition period.

About the College

The college's mission was to extend higher education opportunities to economically disadvantaged and socially marginalized individuals residing in the remote areas of the district and its vicinity. Many of the





students at this college are first-generation learners.

1. Location and Background:

- The college is situated in **Murshidabad**, a historically and culturally fertile region east of the Ganges in **West Bengal**.
- Around **1986**, the area of **Nowda** was a green, isolated countryside where farming was the primary occupation for the local population. Rice, mustard, and jute cultivation formed the backbone of agriculture.

The society was stratified, with education accessible primarily to the elite class.
 Education for girls in the village was negligible, especially among Muslim families where early marriage was common.

2. Founding Vision:

- Sri Jayanta Biswas, an Assistant Teacher at Amtala High School, envisioned gathering support from academics, social workers, and teachers who could rise above self-interest.
- Their efforts and dedication culminated in the establishment of Jatindra
 Rajendra Mahavidyalaya, the only college within a 25-kilometer radius.
- To secure government approval, an initial fund of Rs 1.5 lakh was necessary. Sri Guru Prasad Biswas donated this amount in memory of their fathers, Jatindra and Rajendra, respectively, leading to the college's name.

3. Mission and Impact:

- The college aimed not only to impart knowledge but also to empower economically challenged and socially backward individuals.
- Muslim women, in particular, benefited from higher education, as it played a major role in their empowerment.
- Jatindra Rajendra Mahavidyalaya has received NAAC accreditation twice, reflecting its commitment to quality education in the district.

Rig Vedic women enjoyed high standing in society, and early Indian grammarians like Patanjali and Katyayana suggested that women received education during this period. Here are some key points about women in ancient India:

- 1. Vedic Period:
 - Women married at a mature age and had the freedom to choose their own husbands through practices like **swayamvar** or **Gandharva marriage**.
 - Rig Vedic verses mention women sages and seers, such as Gargi Vachaknavi and Maitreyi.
 - Women were allowed to undergo initiation and study the **Vedas**.
 - Polygamy was matched with **polyandry** during this era.
 - Goddesses were revered, and separate temples were dedicated to them.
- 2. Later Periods:
 - **Maurya Period**: Despite employing female bodyguards, spies, and mahamantras, the status of women declined.
 - **Gupta Period**: Women faced further challenges.
 - Smriti Shastras imposed restrictions on them.
 - **Manu** dictated that women would be dependent on their father in childhood, husband in youth, and son in old age.
- 3. Bright Exceptions:
 - Ancient India boasted many **learned ladies** who contributed significantly to knowledge and culture.
 - Women also played **prominent roles in politics**.



Theme

The Mansabdari system was a grading system used by the Mughal rulers to fix the rank and salary of the Mansabdar. They were nobles who occupied various positions in the administration of the Mughal Empire. They were appointed and dismissed by the Mughal Emperors.

It is true that the absence of the primary administrative documents makes the unraveling of the process of evolution of the Mansabdari system during Akbar's reign a difficult undertaking. However, from the Medieval Indian texts we understand that the salaries of the mansabdars were fixed according to their mansabs, while the rates of their troopers were sanctioned separately. The mansabdars, moreover, were to maintain a separate stable of animals(elephants & horses) on their own according to their mansabs.

The seminar aims to explore the evolution of the Mansabdari system as described in the medieval Indian texts viz., Ain-i-Akbari, Akbar-nama, Tabaqat-i-Akbari.
