INTRODUCTION:

Outline of the Choice Based Credit System being introduced:

- 1. <u>Core Course (CC)</u>: A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.
- 2. <u>Elective Course</u>: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the

student's proficiency/skill is termed as an Elective Course.

2.1 Discipline Specific Elective Course (DSEC): Elective courses that are offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study).

2.2 Generic Elective Course (GEC): An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure is called a Generic Elective.

3. <u>Skill Enhancement Courses</u> (SEC): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide valuebased and/or skill-based instruction.
