#### **ABOUT THE COLLEGE:**

From its historical roots in the fight for women's suffrage to its contemporary expressions focused on intersectionality, reproductive rights, violence against women, gender identity, and more, feminism has sought to address gender inequality in all its forms. The theories of feminism, including liberal feminism, socialist feminism, radical feminism, postmodern feminism, black feminism, and trans-feminism, offer different perspectives on how to achieve gender equality, but all share the common goal of promoting equal rights and opportunities for individuals of all genders. As we continue to strive for a more just and equitable world, feminist theory and activism will undoubtedly play a critical role in shaping the future of gender relations.

- 8) Empowerment: Empowerment of students to advocate for gender equality and challenge discriminatory practices.




