### A Report on Linkages for Faculty Exchange

#### ■ INTRODUCTION:

- 2. Sharing Knolwedge
- 3. Development of Culture and Values among the students, and
- 4. Faculty Exchange

#### **■ OVERVIEW OF PROGRAMME:**

As per the MoU signed on 26.02.2022 between Jatindra Rajendra Mahavidyalaya and Muzaffar Ahmed Mahavidyalaya of Salar, Murshidabad, the Department of Philosophy organized a one day Faculty Exchange Programme on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 by inviting Prof. Soma Dey, Assistant Professor and HoD of Department of Philosophy of latter college as a resource person to teach our students a part of the syllabus on the same day. Prof. Soma delivered an invited lecture for one hour duration.

The host department expressed gratefulness to Prof. Soma Dey for delivering her lecture to our under-graduate students on the topic of "Nyaya Logic". Prof. Pranab Ghosh, coordinator of the programme welcomed the visiting faculty during the inaugural session on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 followed by visiting faculty's introductory class for our under-graduate students and Prof. Tania Khatun, Assistant Professor of Philosophy delivered the vote of thanks in valedictory session highlighting the plan for future collaborative programs. Inaugural session, valedictory session and interaction sessions were chaired by Prof. Geetali Bera, TIC and Associate Professor of Philosophy.
