



Theme of the Seminar:

The mind is responsible for thinking, imagination, memory, wills, and senses, as well as experiencing perception, pleasure, pain, belief, desire, intention, and emotion. It can include conscious and non-conscious states and sensory experiences. Sigmund Freud, a psychologist, developed influential theories about the mind's nature, dividing human consciousness into three levels: conscious, pre-conscious, and unconscious. Each level corresponds to Freud's ideas of the id, ego, and superego, and the mind functions according to the relationship between these characters.

Sigmund Freud's theory of the human mind posits three main components: the id, ego, and superego. The id, present since birth, works on pleasure and primitive principles, generating psychic energy and addressing immediate needs. It is unconscious and impulsive, while the ego, originating from the id, modifies behavior in a socially acceptable manner. It operates in conscious and unconscious ways, analyzing information and making rational decisions. The superego, emerging at age five, consists of moral standards and ideals of the human mind, primarily responsible for making judgments and making appropriate decisions. It is influenced by the moral structure of parents and consists of conscience and the ego ideal. The superego aims to perfect and bring civil sense to our behavior, and is present in conscious, preconscious, and unconscious state of mind.

Freud's theory suggests that these three factors work together to influence an individual's thinking process and behavior. A clear balance between the id, ego, and superego is crucial for developing a healthy personality. An imbalance between these characteristics can indicate a red flag for mental health, and some psychologists suggest that dominant traits may influence decision-making or judgmental skills.
