❖ **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:**

❖ **PROCEDURE:**

First of all, the students who submitted their names to the head of the department of philosophy were grouped into four groups and were seated at the both sides of the class rooms with two groups each side. They were explained about the general rules and regulations of quiz competition and the distribution of marks. The quiz competition covered the five domains of topics such as – Current Affairs, Science and Technology, Sports, Entertainment, and Topics on

Philosophy. Participating students were also provided with Audio-Visuals of the above topics: *songs, movie dialogues, famous speech, and music* and were asked the questions related to them. For each correct answer for allotted question carried 5 marks and 3 marks was assigned for passed on questions. 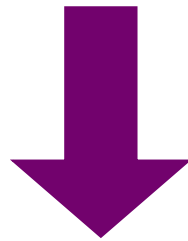

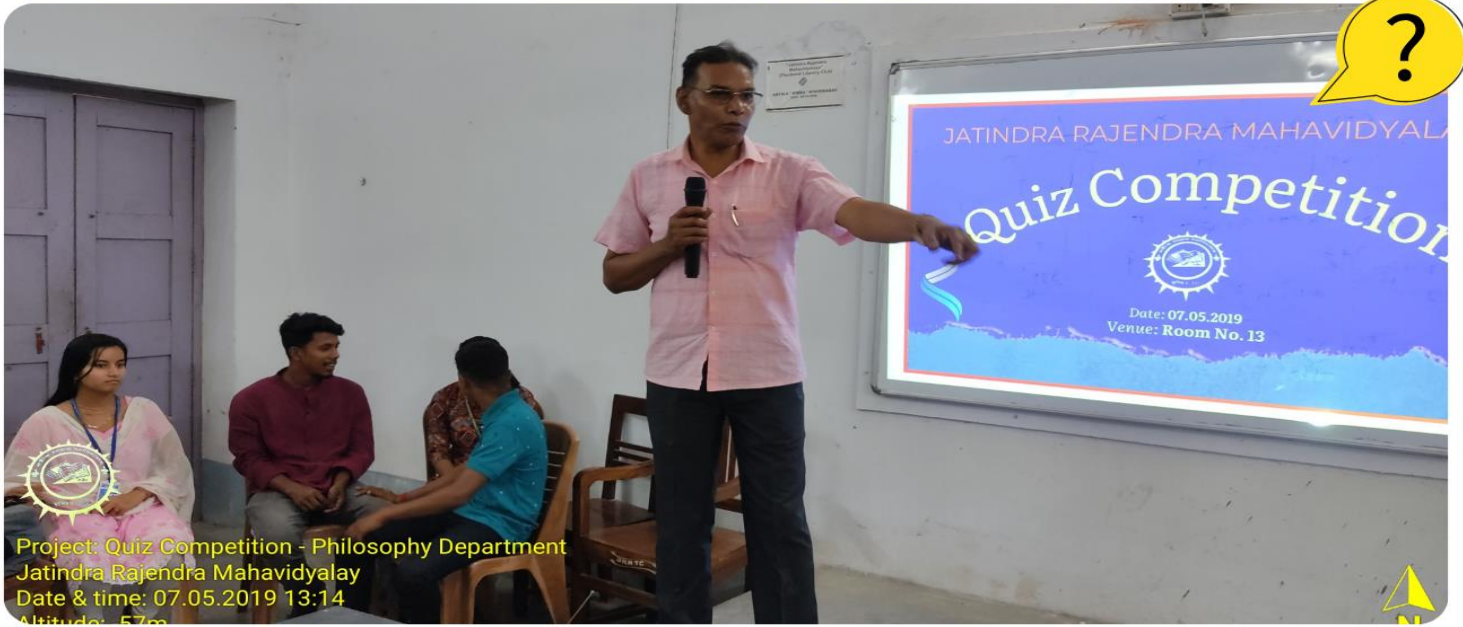

Topic: Indian English Writers and Writings

The Department of English, organized a Literary Quiz Competition focused on Indian English writers and their works on 1st March ,2019. The event aimed to foster a love for literature among students and encourage them to learn more about the rich literary heritage of India.

Participation:

The competition was open to students enrolled in the department's second semester courses. This format allowed for a broader range of participation while catering to different levels of familiarity with the subject. We witnessed enthusiastic participation with four teams registering. Each team consisted of two students.

Format:

The quiz was structured into four rounds, each focusing on various aspects of Indian English Literature. The format has been included:

Multiple Choice: Questions testing core knowledge of prominent figures, plays, poems, and the historical context of the Indian English Writers and Writings.

Identification: Recognizing quotes, characters, or play titles based on excerpts.

True or False: Statements related to Indian English Literature requiring true or false responses.

Matching: Matching playwrights with their corresponding works or poems with their central themes.

Evaluation:

A panel of faculty members from the English department judged the competition. The evaluation process considered the different levels of participation from both semesters. Points were awarded based on the accuracy of answers in each round, with adjustments made to account for the varying difficulty levels. The team with the highest cumulative score, considering their semester, was declared the winner.

Results:

The winning teams from the competition are:

2. Suraj Biswas and Mouli Rajak from the team 2.
3. Mousumi Khatun and Ishita Roy from the team 3.

In the quiz competition, Team 1 has secured the top position, followed by Team 3 in second place, and Team 1 in third place. Succeeding Participants received certificates for their performances in “Indian English Writers and Writings” in addition to the rankings.

Overall Success:

Quiz Competition on “Indian English Writers and Writings” was a resounding success. The event fostered an engaging atmosphere, encouraging students from second semester to actively engage with the rich literary heritage of the Indian English Literature. The competition not only tested their knowledge but also provided a platform for second-semester students to build a strong foundation on Indian English Literature.

Quiz Highlights

Conclusion

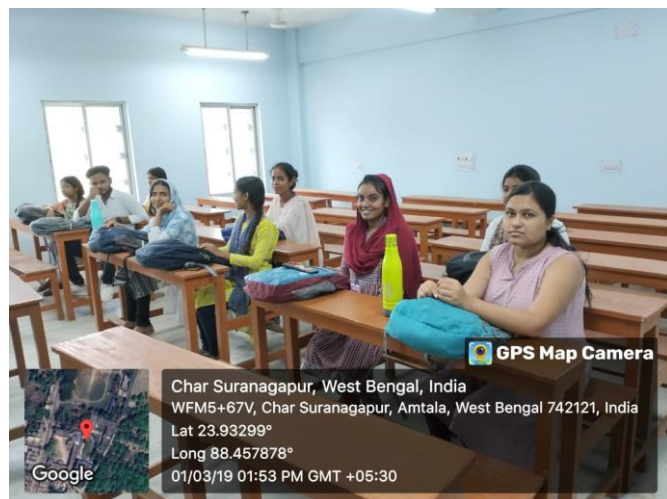
